



Info on 3-G Control (tested, vaccinated, recovered)

Who will be checked?

All persons who enter the UAS via the main entrance and stay at the UAS for longer than 15 minutes (staff, students, external lecturers, visitors).

Persons who will not be at the FHS for longer than 15 minutes, e.g. post office staff, suppliers, laundry service etc., are excluded from the control. These persons must wear a mask.

What will be checked?

- Valid 3G proof: Ideally via the green passport (scan of the QR code) or other 3-G proof.
- Photo ID (e.g. FHS ID card, ID card, passport, driving licence)

No entry to the building without valid 3-G proof!

Which 3G proofs are accepted?

1) Tested

| a) negative molecular biological test (PCR test) | valid 72 hours |
| b) negative antigen test by an authorised body (pharmacy, test lane) | valid 48 hours |
| c) negative antigen self-test recorded in an official data processing system | valid 24 hours |

ATTENTION: The period of validity must include the stay on campus!

2) Vaccinated

|--|---|
| a) Vaccinations with 2 doses (Biontech/Pfizer, Moderna, Astrazeneca) | valid from the day of the 2nd vaccination until 270 days after (9 months) |
| b) Vaccinations with 1 dose (Johnson & Johnson) | valid from the 22nd day after vaccination until 270 days (9 months) after vaccination |
| c) Recovered with 1 vaccination | valid from the day of vaccination until 270 days (9 months) thereafter |

3) Recovered

- | | |
|---|---------------------------|
| a) Proof of recovery or medical confirmation of survived Covid-19 infection | valid 180 days (6 months) |
| b) Proof of neutralising antibodies | valid 90 days (3 months) |
| c) Certificate of isolation issued to a person infected with covid-19 valid 180 days (6 months) | valid 180 days (6 months) |
