<b>Course Content</b>

Express surprise and dissatisfaction, write a biography, make suggestions.  <b>Grammar:</b> verbs with dative and accusative case, adjective declension, reflexive verbs, interrogatives and pronouns, connectors, past tense of modal verbs, relative clauses in the nominative and accusative case.
<b>Learning outcomes</b>
Students understand more complex texts. They are able to read texts on familiar topics and write various simple texts (letters, emails). They can write invitations, acceptances and rejections.
