## Course Content

This course provides the most important information on and insights into Austria. A country that has a lot of history and scenic beauty to offer. In addition to historical, political and geographical facts, students will gain a broader impression of the various influences that have shaped Austrian society and its cul-tural and national identity. Students continuously reflect on their ex-periences and become aware of their own cultural conditioning. Students will not only learn about Austrian culture, they will also experience it as part of an excursion to the top of a mountain.
